Applicants must have had a service related injury or disability incurred or aggravated during active military service; an honorable or medical discharge on a DD214 form; and a letter of recommendation from a commanding officer or reporting senior officer, Wounded Warriors Representative or Veteran Affairs Director. Applicants who meet the above criteria must compose a letter of at least 150 words explaining the need for the woodworking product. Before applicants are selected, all credentials must be reviewed and verified. Not all applicants are guaranteed a machine.
