

PERCEPTION VS REALITY

The public perception of woodworking is hand tool work, typified by the trope of "grandpa in the garage making a wooden chair".

The reality of wood manufacturing is industrial scale production of furniture, flooring, cabinetry, and other interior furnishings made using a combination of skilled labor and (increasingly) automated machinery.

SUSTAINABILITY

Wood, if managed properly, is a perpetually renewable resource. In North America, forests have expanded for over 60 years and are well-tended for harvesting. Without proper management, forests become overgrown with dead material, fueling large forest fires.

Additionally, the decomposition of valuable wood releases carbon into the atmosphere. Using wood for durable products like construction lumber, furniture, and cabinets can naturally sequester carbon for extended periods, as wood is comprised of half carbon by dry weight.




